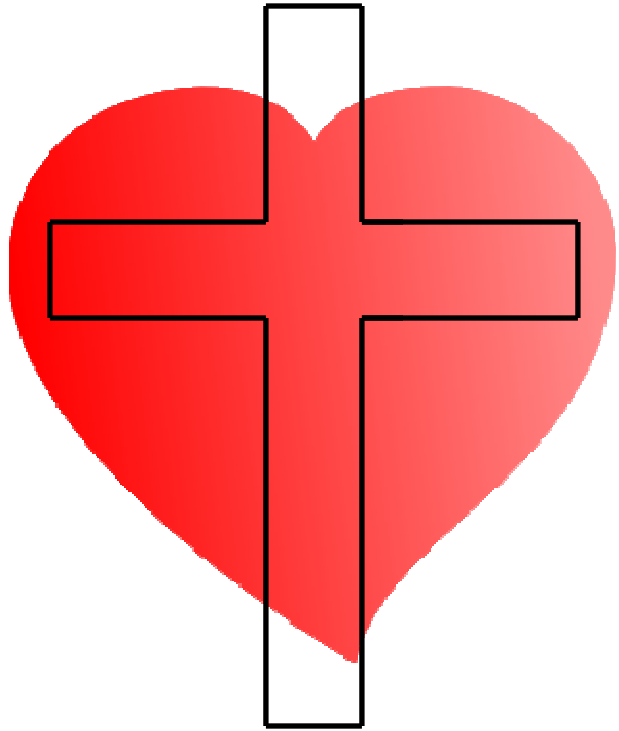


Adopt a Student

Where do my dollars go?
