

**Heartland Lutheran High School

Athletic Director's Report -

1. Recently purchased items include:

 - Medical bag supplies \$76

Balance of \$1600 - need to do more fundraising.

More people are needed to help with concessions and gate.

Pizza Hut has items for a shadow box and Applebee's is now open to letting us in to display HLHS items.

Fall sport schedules are in and we received a check for \$200.

Golf - recommendation from Pastor Bremer concerning golf shirts is for Booster Club to pay \$25 per player and if shirts cost more than that, the student would need to pick up the balance. Motion made by Brian Staehr for HLHS Booster Club to pay \$25 toward girls and boys golf shirts and if shirts cost more than that, the student will pick up the difference. Motion seconded by Carol Spiehs. Motion carried.

Discussed possibility of purchasing new uniforms for basketball next year. Will discuss further at a future meeting.

OLD BUSINESS -

Concessions- Someone has volunteered to act as coordinator for basketball concessions. A message will go out in the October News Letter with details. Only concerns with concessions was that more volunteers are needed.

A secretary is still needed for Booster Club.

Spiritware display is being worked on for SeptemberFest. Betty Seim presented a new item which is a packaged deal consisting of a hoodie, plus a t-shirt in a drawstring bag. Item would sell for \$32 with a profit of \$8 on each bag.

A tailgate party is being planned for October 2nd, prior to the Homecoming Football game. Carol Spiehs will check into a meat donation for burgers and hotdogs. All families attending are asked to bring a side dish or a sealed item (pop/water/etc) to share. Football players will be fed after the game. Pastor Mackey will check into using the Cairo Fire Dept grill.

NEW BUSINESS -

Pastor Mackey advised that if Record Boards are needed for wrestling, golf and football a decision should be made as he may not be able to get the same blue color for formica in the future.

Pastor Mackey has obtained three 3 X 5 sheets of plate glass from the YMCA that he wants to use for trophy cases. Is asking to use the north wall of the commons area and would be about 18-20 linear feet, floor mounted. Shawn Messersmith will bring this up to the board about Booster Club prodeing with this as Booster Club will need support with funds.

Information was given to the Booster Club by Kathy Aufdenberge concerning license plate holders. Item tabled till next meeting to give Betty Seim time to get more information.
