Meeting was called to order by President Betty Seim.
Minutes from the February 8th meeting were read and approved.
Financial report was reviewed and approved as given. \$715 was raised at the Lenten dinner at Trinity on Ash Wednesday. Have applied for matching funds from Thrivent but no reply from them yet.

AD Report:

State Basketball Boys rooms are \$45 for 4 rooms and 3 nights for a total of \$540.
Cheerleaders need a room at \$40 for 2 nights for a total of \$80. Motion made by Brenda Rasmussen to pay for rooms for cheerleaders as long as boys are playing. If boys don't win and cheerleaders want to stay, they would pay for rooms themselves. Motion seconded by Betty Seim. Motion passed.

Track team needs 4 more uniforms at \$40 each for a total of \$160. Motion made by Terri Salter and seconded by Terri Wilson to pay for the track uniforms. Motion passed.
There is an outstanding bill from 2007 & 2008 for track warmups and shirts. \$75.10 is for warmups and \$29.00 for shirts. Motion made by Mark Liess and seconded by Brenda Rasmussen to pay bill. Motion passed.

Discussed when to hold Booster club sports banquet. Dates are May 17th or 18th with boys district golf on the 17th. After discussing other possible dates, it was decided to hold the banquet on May 19th.
We will grill and everyone is asked to bring desserts and salads. Mr. Staehr will check into specifics since the 19th is a Wednesday.

Zenith Football Helmets - made for high profile positions. \$350 a helmet and if you buy 10 you get 2 free. A time to meet with the dealer with several area schools will be set up. Mr Staehrs will let us know when the meeting has been set up if anyone wishes to attend.

Upcoming expenses next year are Boys Basketball uniforms and away Football uniforms.

State Fair Application was presented - there are lots of rules and regulations. A non-refundable \$100 deposit is required with the application.
