

HLHS Booster Club Minutes
July 12, 2010

Meeting was called to order by President Betty Seim.

Motion was made by Robyn Seim and seconded by Steve Wilson to approve minutes from the May meeting. Motion passed.

The Financial Report stands unapproved and tabled until more information can be obtained to how and why monies were taken from the account. These monies had been allocated and the Booster President will contact appropriate persons to hold on ordering approved items.

Athletic Director's Report:

Fees for Activity Passes were discussed and fees will remain the same as last year.

The Press Box is here. A thank you card was signed for Shawn Messersmith and Son's for their hard work and effort to bring it to HLHS. A suggestion for possible fund raiser could be a drawing for the night of football in the press box.

Helmets have been ordered and will arrive soon. Football has 12 boys committed at this time. We have new assistant coaches. Our schedule is better in regard to playing difficult teams. Our equipment is better. The Jr. High program is strong and this should help numbers in the future years.

The Golf Tournament is almost here. So far there are 13 teams each paying an entry fee of \$200. We have 13 hole sponsors which is down some from past years. Indianhead rate is adjusted to \$22 per golfer for our expense. We provide the meal. This year's menu is sloppy joe, chips, salads, cake, and drink. Pepsi has donated 6 cases of pepsi product. Jerrita and Gina are making the sloppy joe, Gina a salad, Betty a salad, Alice a cake. Indianhead has informed us that next year we are locked out of dates in June, July, and August. We may need to look at September for this event next year. Helpers are lined up. We will again sell Mulligans at the rate of \$5 each or 5 for \$25.

A fund raiser was discussed and tabled for now. It was for signs for yards like the hole sponsor signs. They are 24x18 and there is a price break for quantity.

A concern over the restroom facilities for football was raised. As a Booster Club, the President has been given the task of presenting the pros and cons of using the restrooms in the East building for football and make a plea to the school board for their use instead of the portable toilets.

Election of officers

This past year we had a President and Vice President and Secretary was never filled. We do not have a Treasurer due to all monies are handled by the book keeper at school. Betty volunteered to continue as president but asked that we have a secretary position filled to make record keeping more efficient. Then if needed try fill the Vice Presidency at a different time or it could remain open. Deb Norman agreed to accept the Secretary position. The slate of Betty for president and Deb for secretary was voted on and approved.

Concessions Teams

Jerrita and Julie are meeting to set the teams. They will have a list that can be presented at Parent night. We need to advertise for additional volunteers and for persons to cook the ground beef. Betty will contact Carol Peterson to get a request for volunteers out to the Association Churches. We will utilize the teams for concessions and gate. We are looking at possible changes to football gate so all enter at a central location.

Our next meeting was set for Monday August 16 at 7 p.m. This was done so we could invite everyone to come at the Parent meeting.
