

2025-2026 School Supply List



In an attempt to help 7-12 families prepare for the beginning of the next school year, the following list of supplies has been established. If your 9th-12th grade student is enrolled in any of the listed classes, please make sure that you have the supplies for that class. This is not necessarily a comprehensive list as things might be added as teachers continue to plan. 7th-8th grade list and organizational plan is on pages 2-3.

General Supplies

- Pencils, pens, highlighters
- Notebooks, folders, and/or binders with paper and folders –something to take notes, keep track of papers, etc.

Specific Classes

- Theology - a Bible (ESV or NIV preferred)
- Physical Education - We do not require uniforms, but all students in PE (7th, 8th, 9th, and 10th grades) need athletic shorts, athletic shoes, and an appropriate t-shirt (must have sleeves). This also applies to students in Weights and Fitness.
- English - A composition notebook and 1 inch three ring binder
- Math -
 - Pre-Algebra, Algebra I, and Geometry will need a basic scientific calculator. It needs to have trigonometric capabilities. TI-30xIIs is recommended. Graphing calculators are not allowed for Pre-Algebra and Algebra I.
 - A graphing calculator for Algebra II and beyond. Preferred models: TI-83, TI-83+, TI-84, TI-84+
- All music classes - One 1" black three ring binder, band instrument if applicable
 - Handbells - colored highlighters
- Art - A 9x12 sketchbook
- Science
 - 1.5" to 2" three-ring binder with one set of tab dividers
 - Colored pencils- at least a 24 count
 - Loose leaf paper-100 sheets

7th-8th ORGANIZATIONAL PLAN PROCEDURE

Durable pencil/tool bag

They will use this bag to carry needed supplies to each class. Supplies needed for each class will be pencils, pens, eraser, and highlighters.

Spirals

Each subject will have its OWN spiral notebook. The spirals are for notes NOT for homework that is to be turned in. All spirals will be color coded for each class (i.e. red-Literature). If a spiral needs to be replaced, please replace with the same color.

Flexible file folder rather than a binder (13 Pocket)

We feel that the binders are big and bulky for the space we have to work with and thus are requiring the flexible file folder instead. The file folder will be divided in the same way for each grade level. The student will be expected to use it to store blank notebook paper for assignments, daily assignments for each class, and completed homework. We ask that children set up their expandable file folders prior to the first day of school.

All spiral notebooks for the Jr. High will be labeled using the following colors and subjects.

(You may substitute colors if you are unable to find the ones listed)

Literature	= Red
Science	= Green
Math	= Yellow
English	= Orange
Religion	= Purple
Social Studies	= Black
Fine Arts	= Lt. Blue
Elective	= Any Color
Writing	= Any Color

All book covers can have the same color present on the spine of the book to help with organization. (i.e. English would have an orange dot on the spine of the book cover.)

The expandable file folder will be labeled as follows:

The 1st pocket: Spelling

2nd	: English
3rd	: Fine Arts (Music, Art, etc.)
4th	: Literature
5th	: Math
6th	: Religion
7th	: Science
8th	: Social Studies
9th	: Elective
10th	: Writing
11th	: Returned Papers
12th	: Graph Paper
13th	: Loose Leaf Notebook Paper
